

## Draws confirmed for the Open Menorca ATP Challenger 100

- *Albert Ramos-Viñolas, Marin Čilić and Billy Harris lead a strong singles field*
- *Sebastian Ofner and Carlos Taberner aim to shine during a key week on clay*
- *In doubles, the Vavassori brothers and the Spanish duo Álvarez Varona-Taberner are among the top names to watch*

Menorca, 30 March 2025 – The **Club Tenis Ciutadella** now knows its match-ups. The **Open Menorca ATP Challenger 100**, taking place from 31 March to 6 April, has officially announced the draws for singles, doubles, and the qualifying rounds.

This international tournament is supported by the **Balearic Islands Tourism Strategy Agency (AETIB)**, the **Consell Insular de Menorca**, and the **Ajuntament de Ciutadella de Menorca**, along with a solid group of corporate and sports sponsors.

The main sponsors include: San Miguel, Solán de Cabras, Joma, Marca, bolt 6, Conecta Balear and Led Projects, among others.

### Main Draw: Experience meets rising talent

British player **Billy Harris** (ATP No. 107) heads the draw as top seed, in a field that mixes seasoned names with promising new faces.

Notable contenders include Croatia's **Marin Čilić**, third seed and winner of 21 ATP titles, including the 2014 US Open and the 2016 Cincinnati Masters 1000; Spain's **Albert Ramos-Viñolas**, a Monte Carlo Masters finalist with four ATP titles; and fifth seed **Carlos Taberner**, who has seven Challenger titles on clay and thrives on this surface.

Spanish talents also include **Daniel Rincón**, 2021 US Open junior champion, and **Javier Barranco Cosano**, a doubles specialist with several Challenger titles to his name.

Austria's **Sebastian Ofner**, the second seed, rounds out a strong group of title contenders.

The top half of the draw kicks off with a standout clash: **Harris versus Ramos-Viñolas** in the round of 32. Meanwhile, **Ofner and Čilić**, both placed in the bottom half, could potentially meet in the semi-finals—if their opponents allow it.

## Qualifying: Fight for a place in the main draw

The qualifying rounds begin today, Sunday 30 March, with 24 players competing for six available spots in the main draw.

Top names include **Zsombor Piros** (HUN), **Rudolf Molleker** (GER), **Kimmer Coppejans** (BEL), and Spain's **Bernabé Zapata Miralles**, who returns to the circuit after injury.

There's also a strong Spanish presence with **Daniel Mérida**, **Carlos López Montagud**, **Miguel Damas**, **Max Alcalá Gurri**, **Sergio Martos Gornés** and wildcard entry **Izan Corretja** all in action.

The qualifying draw promises fierce competition, with seasoned players and young prospects ready to leave everything on the Menorcan clay.

## Doubles: Firepower and local favourites

In doubles, India's **Jeevan Nedunchezhiyan** and **Vijay Sundar Prashanth** top the seedings.

Italian brothers **Andrea** and **Matteo Vavassori**, invited by the organisers, are expected to deliver high-energy tennis and dynamic net play.

Spanish pair **Carlos** Taberner and Nicolás **Álvarez Varona** will enjoy home support, while second seeds **Johannes Ingildsen** (DEN) and **David Stevenson** (GBR) bring a balanced, solid pairing to the table.

Other key teams include **Daniel Cukierman & Joshua Paris** and **Kaliyanda Poonacha & Sergio Martos Gornés**, seeded third and fourth respectively.
