

## Six players book their place in the main draw at the Open Menorca ATP Challenger 100

• Monday's packed schedule completed the first round and wrapped up the second qualifying stage, following Sunday's postponements due to strong winds.

• Piros, Coppejans, Campana Lee, Gombos, Alcalá Gurri and Feldbausch have all secured their place in the main draw after a demanding day across the three courts of Club Tennis Ciutadella.

• High-level competition in a tournament that has firmly established its presence in Ciutadella, backed by public institutions and private sponsors.

Menorca, 31 March 2025 – On Monday 31 March, **Club Tennis Ciutadella** played host to a decisive day at the **Open Menorca ATP Challenger 100**. The postponed matches from Sunday's first round were played, along with all final-round qualifying clashes, confirming the six players who move on to the main draw. Twelve matches across three courts made for a full day of top-level tennis.

### Marathon day wraps up qualifying and defines the final line-up

The second day of action at the **Open Menorca ATP Challenger 100** – supported by **AETIB**, the **Consell Insular de Menorca** and **Ajuntament de Ciutadella**, alongside sponsors including San Miguel, Solán de Cabras, Joma, Marca, Bolt 6, Conecta Balear and Led Projects – has officially concluded the qualifying rounds of this ATP Challenger 100 tournament.

The six players who have made it into the main draw are:

- **Zsombor Piros (HUN) [1]**
- **Kimmer Coppejans (BEL) [3]**
- **Gerard Campana Lee (KOR) [7]**
- **Norbert Gombos (SVK) [8]**
- **Max Alcalá Gurri (ESP) [10]**
- **Kilian Feldbausch (SUI)**

It was an intense and demanding day, starting at 10:00 am and stretching into the late afternoon, filled with high-quality matches, comebacks and a few retirements due to injury.

### Centre Court: dominant wins and an unexpected retirement

On Centre Court, **Kilian Feldbausch** pulled off an early surprise by taking the first set 4-6 against **Bernabé Zapata Miralles**, who later retired in the second set trailing 0-3, after struggling with physical issues and visibly frustrated.

Later, **Kimmer Coppejans** delivered a double bagel to young Spaniard **Izan Corretja** in just 46 minutes, before sealing his spot in the main draw with a solid 7-5, 6-1 win over **Ryan Nijboer**.

Spaniard **Daniel Mérida** mounted a strong comeback against Austria's **Neil Oberleitner**, recovering from a 0-6 first set to win 6-3, 6-3 – although he narrowly missed out on qualifying.

**Feldbausch** secured his main draw place in a tense encounter with **Norbert Gombos**, winning 4-6, 6-4, 5-2 before the Slovak player retired.

### San Miguel Court 2: Piros on form, Alcalá Gurri through in style

Over on Court 2, **Miguel Damas** defeated India's **Ramkumar Ramanathan** with a composed 3-6, 4-6 performance, but couldn't get past top seed **Zsombor Piros**, who saw him off 6-3, 6-1.

The Hungarian had already come through a tough three-set battle earlier in the day against **Alex Molcan** (4-6, 7-5, 6-0), showing strength and focus in both of his matches.

**Max Alcalá Gurri** also secured his place in the main draw with a composed 5-7, 2-6 victory over Germany's **Marko Topo**, in a match that had started out evenly but quickly shifted in favour of the Spaniard.

### Joma Court 3: Campana Lee and Gombos assert their quality

On Court 3, **Gerard Campana Lee** of South Korea continued his impressive run, easing past **Alberto Barroso Campos** 6-2, 6-3, and finishing the qualifying rounds without dropping a set.

**Norbert Gombos** had to dig deep to overcome **Pablo Masjuan Ginel** in a two-hour match, eventually winning 6-4, 4-6, 3-6 to keep his hopes alive earlier in the day.

However, **Ryan Nijboer**, who had earlier knocked out **Daniel Cukierman** (0-6, 6-7), was unable to maintain momentum against **Coppejans** in the evening, with the Belgian closing out his qualification run with authority.

Monday's action has confirmed the final names completing the tournament's main draw, which will run through to Sunday 6 April. With a diverse line-up of international players, the Open Menorca ATP Challenger 100 strengthens its place on the pro circuit and continues to build its identity as a key event in the stunning setting of Ciutadella.
