

## Open Menorca to launch ticket sales this Saturday, 17 January

*The only ATP tournament in the Balearic Islands during the clay season offers a full week of elite tennis in Ciutadella, from 29 March to 5 April*

**Menorca, 15 January 2026** – The 2nd edition of Open Menorca ATP Challenger 100 launches ticket sales this Saturday 17 January for the tournament taking place from 29 March to 5 April at the Club Tenis Ciutadella. The release coincides with Menorca's Sant Antoni holiday and marks the beginning of a week filled with top-level professional tennis.

As the only ATP tournament in the Balearic Islands during the clay season, Open Menorca offers a unique chance to enjoy elite-level tennis in a natural and intimate setting. Tickets start at €10, with full-week passes from €95, available at [www.openmenorca.com](http://www.openmenorca.com). Entry on the first two days of play (Sunday 29 and Monday 30 March) is free of charge, but advance reservation is required via the tournament website.

The centre court stands and communal areas have been redesigned to welcome more attendees and enhance the overall comfort, both for local fans and for those travelling to the island for the event.
